The Seed of Woman

1. Enmity

- 1. **Genesis 3:15** "I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and her offspring;
- 2. he shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise his heel."
- 3. Enmity between the seed of Satan and the seed woman.
- 4. Enmity Treating one as an enemy

2. Seed = The Coming Messiah

- 1. Born of a virgin
 - 1. Isaiah 7:14
 - 2. Matthew 1:22-23
- 2. He would be the seed of a woman and made of a woman (Genesis 4:4).

3. Bruising Christ's heel

- 1. **Crucifying** Jesus was "victory" in the mind of Satan.
- 2. **Resurrection** was God's victory over Satan.

4. The Atonement of Calvary

- **1 John 3:8** "Whoever makes a practice of sinning is of the devil, for the devil has been sinning from the beginning. The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the works of the devil."
- 2. **Hebrews 2:14-15** "14 Since therefore the children share in flesh and blood, he himself likewise partook of the same things, that through death he might destroy the one who has the power of death, that is, the devil, 15 and deliver all those who through fear of death were subject to lifelong slavery."

The Subtlety of the Serpent

1. See what you can't have.

- The serpent made Eve focus on the ONE prohibited tree rather than ALL the other trees permitted.
- 2. Genesis 3:1
- 3. Eve's mistakes
 - 1. Eve Lingers (4:7)
 - Eve adds to God's word (Genesis 2:26-7, 3:2-3).
 - Eve waters down God's warning (Genesis 2:17, 3:3).

2. See what God is keeping from you.

- 1. The Plan (Genesis 3:4-5).
- 2. The "not" in the serpent's tale
 - 1. The Lie (Genesis 3:4).
 - 2. The Devil's native tongue (John 8:44).
- 3. The empty promises.
 - 1. Genesis 3:5.
 - 2. Satan always promises what he can't deliver.
 - 1. He promised open eyes.
 - 2. He promised a position with God Himself.
 - 3. He promised life instead of death.

The Sin of Man

1. The Sight of Sin

- 1. "Delight to the eyes" (Genesis 3:6).
- 2. "Lust of the eyes" (1 John 2:16).
- 3. Adam walked into these temptations with his eyes wide open (1 Timothy 2:14).

2. The Shame of Sin

- 1. Genesis 3:7
 - 1. They saw their sinful state.
 - 2. Satan had promised them honor and glory, but they received sin and shame.
- 2. Genesis 3:8
 - 1. Sin robbed them of their courage and turned them into cowards.
 - 2. They used to have **companionship** but not they have **concealment** from God.

3. The Salary of Sin

- 1. Makes on lost (Genesis 3:9).
- 2. Sin drives man away from God (Genesis 3:23).
- 3. Sin caused death, sickness, pain, and suffering to come into the world (Romans 5:12).
- 4. From this moment, man has not enjoyed the presence of God as Adam had.
