Special Precepts

- 1. God gave the children of Israel his ten commandments (Exodus 20:3-17)
- 2. There are some 600 laws given throughout the Law of Moses which are an expansion on the Ten Commandments
- 3. The Ten Commandments are made of 4 commandments that deal with how man should respect God.
 - 1. No God but the Lord (Exodus 20:2-3).
 - 2. No carved images worshipped (Exodus 20:4).
 - 3. The Lord's name was to be reverenced (Exodus 20:7).
 - 4. The Lord's sabbath was to be remembered and reverenced (Exodus 20:8).
- 4. The Ten Commandments are made of 6 commandments that deal with how men should respect their neighbors
 - 1. The first and key to respecting fellow man is respecting parents (Exodus 20:12).
 - 2. Respect mans life do not murder (Exodus 20:13).
 - 3. Respect a mans relationships (Exodus 20:14).
 - 4. Respect a mans property (Exodus 20:15).
 - 5. Respect a mans character (Exodus 20:16).
 - 6. Respect a mans possessions (Exodus 20:17).

5. Put To Work

- 1. The law that was given at Mount Sinai was never meant to be permanent, but it was to bring man to Christ.
 - 1. Galatians 3:19.
 - 2. Colossians 2:14.
- 2. Jesus summed up the entire law in just this way (Mark 12:29-31).
- 3. To truly love God, I must keep His commandments (John 14:15).
- 4. If I love God, keeping His commandments are easier.

1. Mount Sinai

 - 1. Those chosen before the foundation of the world.
 - 2. **Ephesians 1:4-5** "4 even as he chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him. In love 5 he predestined us for adoption to himself as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his will,"

Special People

1. Israel was God's special treasure

- 1. He lifted them up like a mother eagle (exodus 19:4).
- 2. The had to keep His covenant (Exodus 19:5).
- 3. God is about to give Israel a law to keep as His people.
- 4. Though all the earth belongs to the Lord, He chose Israel as His special people.
 - 1. Genesis 18:19.
 - 2. Deuteronomy 4:37.

2. God wanted to make His people into a kingdom

- 1. Exodus 19:6.
- 2. God was the King.
 - 1. In this kingdom, God ruled over them.
 - 2. 1 Samuel 8:7
- 3. They were a kingdom of priests.

3. Put to work
