 - 2. The Lord will be with Moses (Exodus 4:12).
- 3. Lord send someone else (Exodus 4:13).
 - 1. God said Aaron will speak for Moses and he is already on his way to meet him (Exodus 4:14).
 - 2. God provides every need for Moses so that he has no excuse.

The Plot

1. Egypt enslaves Israel

- 1. Because of fruitfulness (Exodus 1:7).
- 2. Because of fear (Exodus 1:8-10).

2. Israel endured affliction and continued to grow

- 1. Israel built under burden (Exodus 1:11).
- 2. The more they were afflicted the more they grew (Exodus 1:12).
- 3. The lived miserable lives (Exodus 1:13-14).

3. Midwives stayed faithful

- 1. Pharaoh instructs them to kill the Israelite male babies (Exodus 1:15-16).
- 2. The midwives chose to serve God (Exodus 1:17).
- 3. The midwives were blessed (Exodus 1:20-21).

4. Put to work

- 1. Satan was afraid that Jesus would fulfill God's plan of salvation therefore he tempted him to sin (Matthew 4).
 - 1. Satan is afraid we will submit to join God.
 - 2. James 4:7.
- 2. God turned the brutal treatment of Jesus into the greatest blessing for man (John 3:16).
- 3. Christ stayed faithful to God until the end. Christians must endure until the end to inherit eternal life (Revelation 2:10).

The Person

1. The Birth and Adoption of Moses

- 1. Moses had faithful parents that hid him for three months instead of obeying Pharaoh (Exodus 2:1-2).
- 2. Moses was strategically placed in the Nile (Exodus 2:3-5).
- 3. Pharaoh's daughter had compassion (Exodus 2:6).
- 4. Moses's real mother raised him (Exodus 2:7-9).
- 5. Moses because Pharaoh's grandson (Exodus 2:10).

2. Moses Chose His Brethren Over The Egyptians

- 1. Moses was educated (Acts 7:22).
- 2. Moses goes to help his people (Exodus 2:11 and Acts 7:23).
- 3. He chose God over glory (Hebrews 11:24-26).

3. Moses Defended the Defenseless

- 1. Defended his people and was rejected by him
 - 1. Exodus 2:11-15
 - 2. Acts 7:25
- 2. Defended helpless strangers and was accepted by them
 - 1. Jethro had 7 daughters that helped water the flock (Exodus 2:16).
 - 2. Moses defended the women from the shepherds (Exodus 2:17).
 - 3. Moses was given a place to live and a wife (Exodus 2:17-22).

4. Put To Work

- 1. Like Moses, Christ was hidden from an evil King after His birth (Matthew 2:13).
- 2. Jesus left royalty to save those who would be called His brethren (John 1:14).
- 3. Jesus came to his own and was rejected for the most part (John 1:11).
