Partakers of the Lamb

1. The children of Israel were commanded to eat the Passover

- 1. They were to eat it in haste (12:11).
- 2. They were to be ready to leave at a moments notice.

2. They would keep this feast throughout their history to remember what the Lord did in Egypt

- Exodus 12:14 ""This day shall be for you a
 memorial day, and you shall keep it as a feast to
 the LORD; throughout your generations, as a
 statute forever, you shall keep it as a feast."
- 2. They were to teach their children (Exodus 12:25-27).

3. As God's children we are partakers of the body of Christ

- 1. The Lord instituted the Lord's supper during the Passover meal (1 Corinthians 11:24-25).
- 2. This is to be a memorial to remember the broken body and blood of Christ.
- 3. This is to teach and to remind us of the Lord's death until He comes (1 Corinthians 11:26).

What kind of Lamb?

1. Without spot and blemish

- 1. The Passover Lamb had to be without blemish.
 - 1. Exodus 12:5.
 - 2. God had to have the best from His people, this was a healthy lamb without imperfections.
- 2. Christ is our Pure Passover Lamb.
 - 1. He was without spot and blemish (1 Peter 1:18-19).
 - 2. Jesus lived His entire life on earth without committing sin.
 - 1. He was tempted in every way (Hebrews 4:15).
 - 2. He committed no sin (1 Peter 2:22).
 - 3. Jesus was the only man that has ever lived a sinless life on this earth and that made him qualified to offer himself as the atonement for our sins.
 - 1. 2 Corinthians 5:21.
 - 2. 1 John 2:2.

2. A lamb a year old in its strength of life

- 1. Exodus 12:5.
- 2. Jesus died at a young age, in the strength of His life.

Blood of the Lamb

- 1. The Israelites had to cover the blood on their door posts to be passed over (Exodus 12:7).
- 2. The houses covered with the blood would be passed over (Exodus 12:12-13).
- 3. The destroyer would pass over the blood covered houses (Exodus 12:23).
- 4. Only those covered with the blood of Christ will be passed over.
 - 1. I am justified through the blood of Christ.
 - 1. Romans 5:9.
 - 2. It is Just-If-Ide never sinned.
 - 2. I have redemption through the blood of Christ
 - 1. Ephesians 1:7
 - 2. To redeem is to buy back he was released from the payment of sin.
 - 3. We have forgiveness or pardon through his blood

5. To com in contact with His blood I must be baptized.

- 1. Christ shed His blood in His death and baptism is where I come in contact with His death and His blood.
 - 1. Romans 6:3-4.
 - 2. Colossians 2:12.
