- 1. Because he obeyed God (Genesis 6:22).
- 2. Because he was righteous (Genesis 7:1).
- 3. Because he was faithful till the end (Genesis 7:16).
- 4. Those who are of the world (Genesis 7:17-24).

## 2. Set apart to sacrifice to God

- 1. Noah dedicated sacrifices to God (Genesis 8:20).
- 2. Christians set apart in the church offer spiritual sacrifices (1 Peter 2:5).
- 3. Sacrifice of song (Colossians 3:16).
- 4. Sacrifice of study (2 Timothy 2:15).
- 5. Sacrifice of service (James 1:27).

#### 3. Set apart to bring the savior

- 1. The descendants of Shem (Genesis 11:10-26).
- One of the last to be listed is Abram (Genesis 11:26) who will one day be renamed Abraham (Genesis 17:5).
- 3. Abraham means "father of a multitude."
- 4. He is also a forefather of Christ (Matthew 1:1).

## Sin of Man

#### 1. Sin is Serious

- 1. God cannot approve of sin (Habakkuk 1:13).
- 2. Don't fool yourself, God cannot delight, accept, or ignore iniquity.
- 3. God hates sin (Proverbs 6:16-19).
- 4. God is against those that do wrong (1 Peter 3:12; Psalms 11:5; Genesis 6:11-12).

#### 2. Sin Spreads

- 1. Sinfulness spread to everybody.
- 2. Every thought of man was evil (Genesis 6:5).
- 3. The deadly decay of sin had spread (Genesis 6:12).

## 3. Long Suffering of God

- 1. Noah found grace in the eyes of God (Genesis 6:8).
- 2. God waited for Noah's family (1 Peter 3:20).
- 3. God was waiting for others (2 Peter 2:5).
  - God waited for others to be saved through Noah's preaching, yet nobody listened for 100 years.
  - 2. God brought the flood when his long-suffering ran out, nobody was going to repent.

# **Ship of Salvation**

## 1. Singleness of the Ship

- 1. Command given (Genesis 6:14).
- 2. Command followed (Hebrews 11:7).
- 3. There was only only place for man to be saved in the days of Noah, the same applies today (Galatians 3:26; Ephesians 5:23).

## 2. Structure and symbols of the ship

- 1. The was one ark built out of gopher wood (Genesis 6:14), one church where men are saved (Ephesians 4:4), purchased upon the wood of Calvary (Acts 20:28).
- 2. Large enough to fit all kinds of animals.
  - 1. 450' long, 75' wide, 45' tall (Genesis 6:15).
  - 2. Fits 2 of every kind of animal (Genesis 6:19-21).
  - 3. Church is where all are saved (Isaiah 2:2).
- 3. A window for light and door for entrance (Genesis 6:16).
  - 1. Jesus is the light of the world (John 8:12).
  - 2. Jesus is the door to salvation
    - 1. John 10:9
    - 2. John 14:6
