## 1. All knowing God

1. God exists outside of time, therefore He can see all of time as if it were a line in front of Him.
2. This allowed for God to look beyond the two in the garden who were naked and ashamed as sinners.
  1. Why didn't He destroy them? It was through that woman's seed that the savior would come.
  2. Genesis 3:15
3. He could look past the people who's heart was evil continually and devoured by the flood, because he would see a people that would be forgiven.
4. God could look past the rejection of Israel in the wilderness because He could see a people that would not reject Him (Christians).
5. He sees the Jews in Babylon who had been carried away because of idolatry, because He would send them home for the savior was not born in Babylon but Bethlehem.

1. Why did God not send His Son to the Garden where man sinned?
2. Why did God not send His Son to Egypt when His people were in bondage?
3. Why did God not send His Son to Israel when idolatry was running rampant?

5. **Galatians 4:4-5** "4 But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law, 5 to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons."

# The Pre-Creation Christ

## 1. Who was there in the beginning?

1. **The Godhead** (Genesis 1:26).
2. God The Father - **The Designer** (Genesis 1:3, 9).
3. God The Word - **The Creator** (Genesis 1:1, John 1:1, 3).
4. God The Spirit - **The Organizer and Beautifier** (Genesis 2:2).

## 2. Was Jesus at the beginning?

1. **John 1:14** "And the **Word became flesh and dwelt among us**, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth."
2. **Colossians 1:16** "**For by him all things were created, in heaven and on earth**, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—**all things were created through him and for him.**"
3. **Hebrews 1:1-2** "1 Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, 2 **but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world.**"

# The Pre-Creation Plan

## 1. Why did God create man?

1. **Jeremiah 1:5** "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you; I appointed you a prophet to the nations."
2. He understood man would sin

## 2. He had a plan to save man before He created man?

1. To be conformed to the image of His Son (Romans 8:29-30).
2. He chose man to be saved through His Son (Ephesians 1:3-5).

## 3. He planned to give His Son before He created man.

1. Planned Sacrifice (1 Peter 1:19-20).
2. Sacrificed in prospect before creation (Revelation 13:8).

## 4. When did God give His Son?

1. Before He created the world, and therefore gave His Son before the worlds foundation.
2. **John 3:16** "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life."
3. He knew that becoming flesh would have to go to the grave.
4. He put the breath into man that would one day take his breath away.
