Doxology

"24 Now to him who is able to keep you from stumbling and to present you blameless before the presence of his glory with great joy, 25 to the only God, our Savior, through Jesus Christ our Lord, be glory, majesty, dominion, and authority, before all time and now and forever. Amen." Jude 24-25

This is the end of the shortest book in the New Testament. Jude packs so much great information into only 25 verses. Right at the end of the chapter we see such a beautiful piece of scripture about the glory that God deserves. In fact the phrase "doxology" itself is a proclamation of praise within itself.

The point of the doxology is to point to the one who is able to hold fast to you and present you blameless before the presence of God. Having the ability to cleanse someone to the point of presenting them to God with joy in knowing their cleanliness is worth praising in the eyes of Jude. Jesus is capable of washing our sins away and in doing so is joyful for the opportunity to deliver us before God proud of the new creation that we are in Him. The question is, do I live my life to where I can be cleansed from sin and bring joy to Jesus to present me to the Father?
